

WV Project CommuniTree Planting at Shepherd University in Shepherdstown

The tree planting was held on October 26th at Shepherd

demonstration on how to properly plant a tree. Everyone divided up into small groups to plant the trees. Once the volunteers were finished planting the trees, they staked, mulched, and watered them using a water from the nearest dorm.
