

## WV Project CommuniTree Planting at Caperton Boulevard Business Park

As an environmentally friendly business, QuadGraphics has taken steps to increase tree canopy on their property in the Caperton Boulevard Business Park in Martinsburg by planting trees through WV Project CommuniTree.

The tree planting took place over the course of two separate days, April 18 and May 3, to accommodate different shifts and engage as many volunteers as possible. The second tree planting day coincided with Quad/Graphic's annual earth day celebration and clean-up event.

Matt Pennington from Region 9 led planting demonstrations on both planting days, covering the dual topics of *how* to plant trees as well as *why* it's important to plant trees and increase tree canopy in an area with lots of development like Martinsburg.

One of the volunteers commented that the planting demonstration was reminiscent of travelling to Colonial Williamsburg, wherein the content was educational but also presented in a fun and engaging manner.

This was the second tree planting that QuadGraphics has organized at the Caperton Boulevard Business Park. With the 24 trees



planted in <u>fall 2015</u>, the total number of trees planted through WV Project CommuniTree at this site is 48.
